# THE NO F STREET SUPER CORRIDOR GROUP

formed after getting inconsistent responses from the county and city regarding increased speeds, increased traffic, decreased property values and chronic traffic accidents (especially at Oak & F).

Redwood Community Action Agency conducted a Walkability Study in 2011 that recommended a safety light at that time but instead the county chose to install partial recommendations for a school crosswalk.

In the last decade, Holly Street in Cutten has received speed bumps for a small price while Rex Bohn's Baseball Field at Fern & Walnut received a safety light without having to meet the same criteria. The Department of Transportation Guidelines are clear that Oak & F qualified for a light and pending that expense, 4-way stop signs. As we've been told "red tape" has gotten in the way of protecting our lives, our property and those passing through, our Group has come together to demand something be done and to educate others of their risks.

A Petition with 242 signatures demanding immediate mitigation occur was sent out on August 24, 2020. The area continues to be ignored while other projects receive more attention: The Municipal Golf Course, Eureka's Grand Entryway, Broadway to name a few. We await our Representatives to schedule a community meeting to move forward in this process.

We hope you'll join us in expecting our Representatives to do their jobs by keeping us involved in the process, and mitigating the issues that have developed due to a decade of neglect.

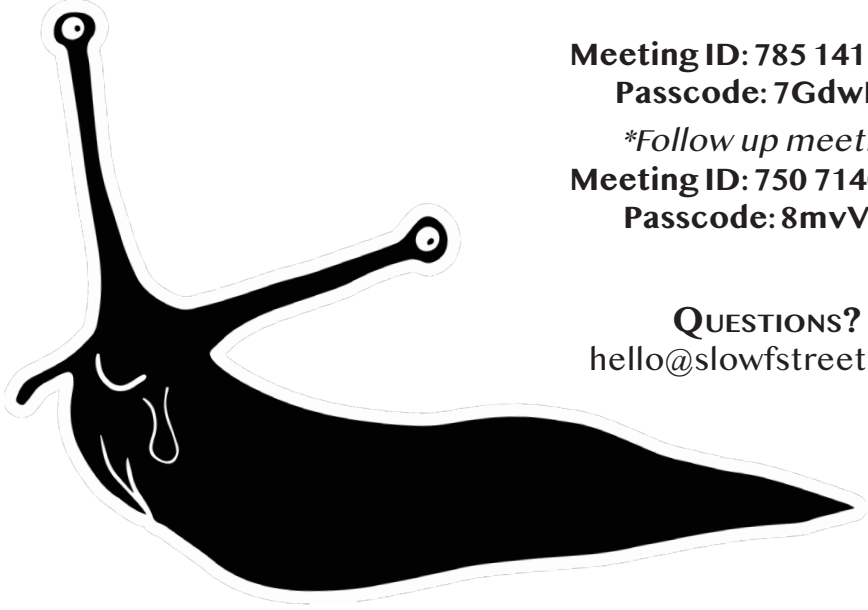
